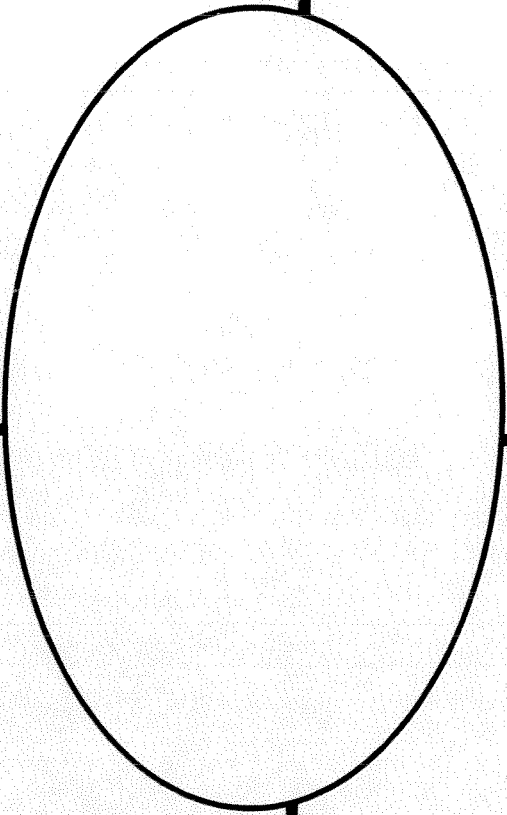

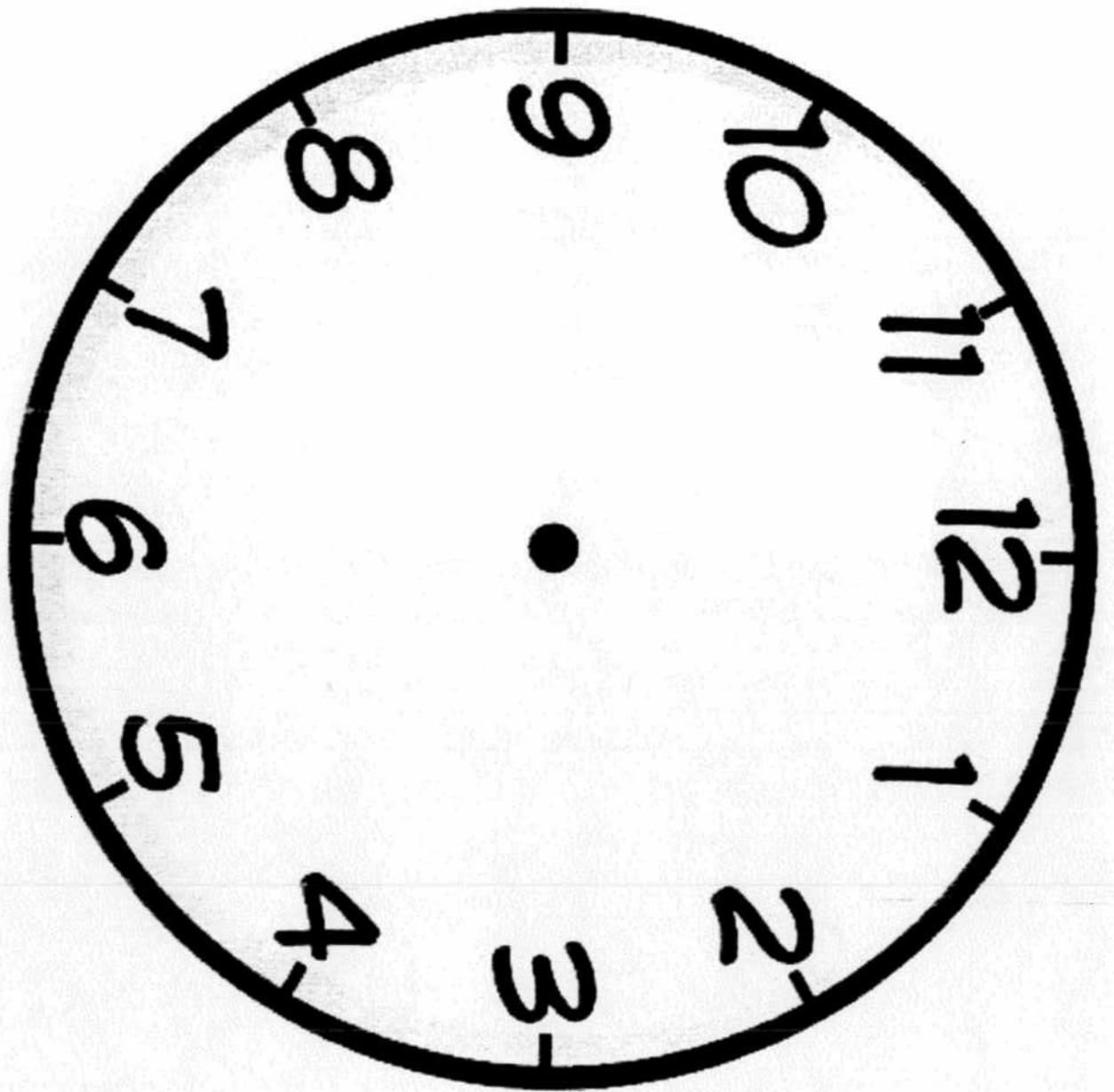

- 9 are to be clean and neatly groomed, and those who work around moving
- 10 equipment will be required to maintain shoulder length hair or secure it

Sequence Signals: There is an order to these ideas.

Emphasis Signals: This is important!

Conclusion Signals: This ends the discussion and may have special importance.

Cause, Condition, or Result Signals: Condition or modification coming.

Comparison-Contrast Signals: We will now compare Idea A with Idea B.

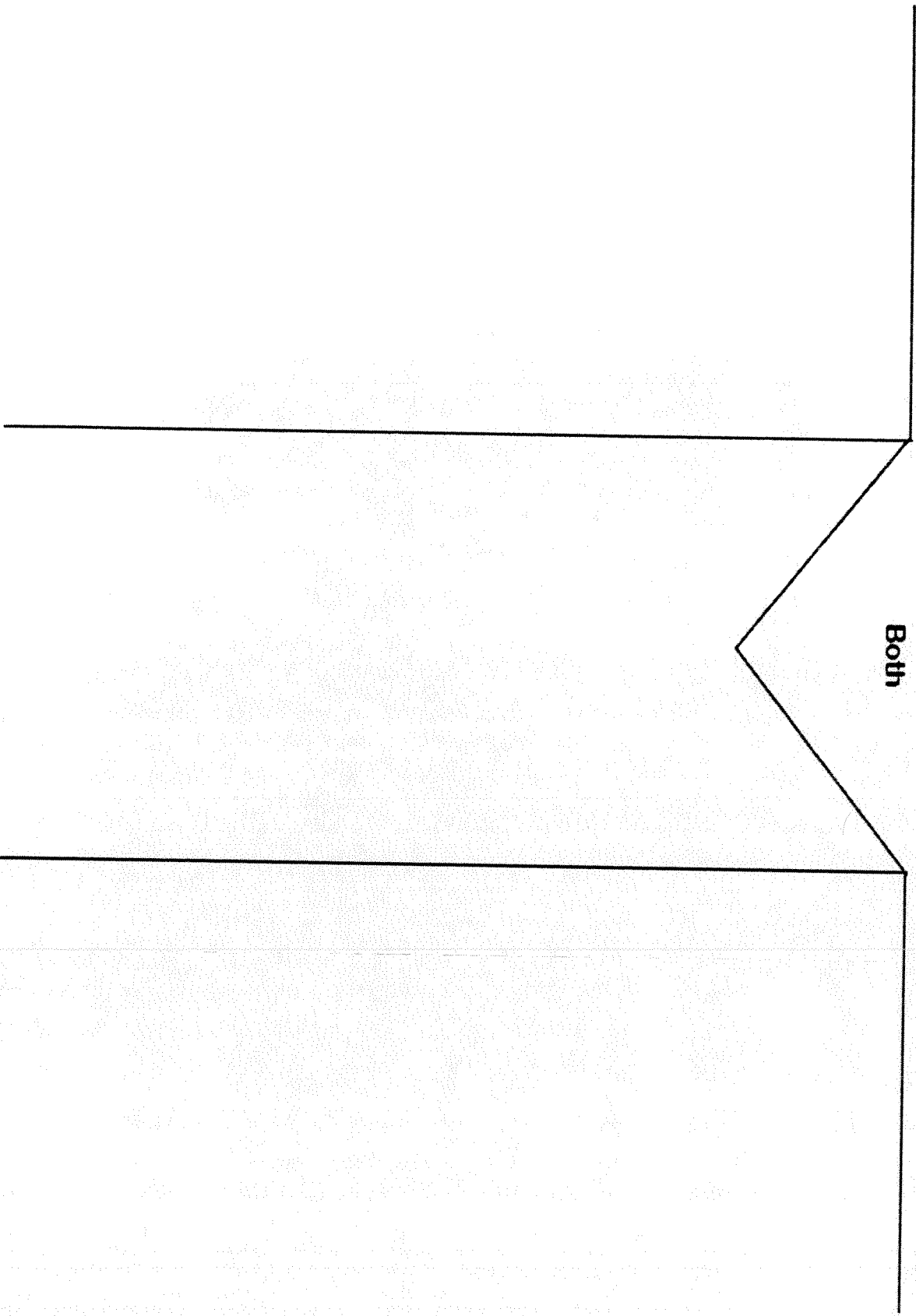

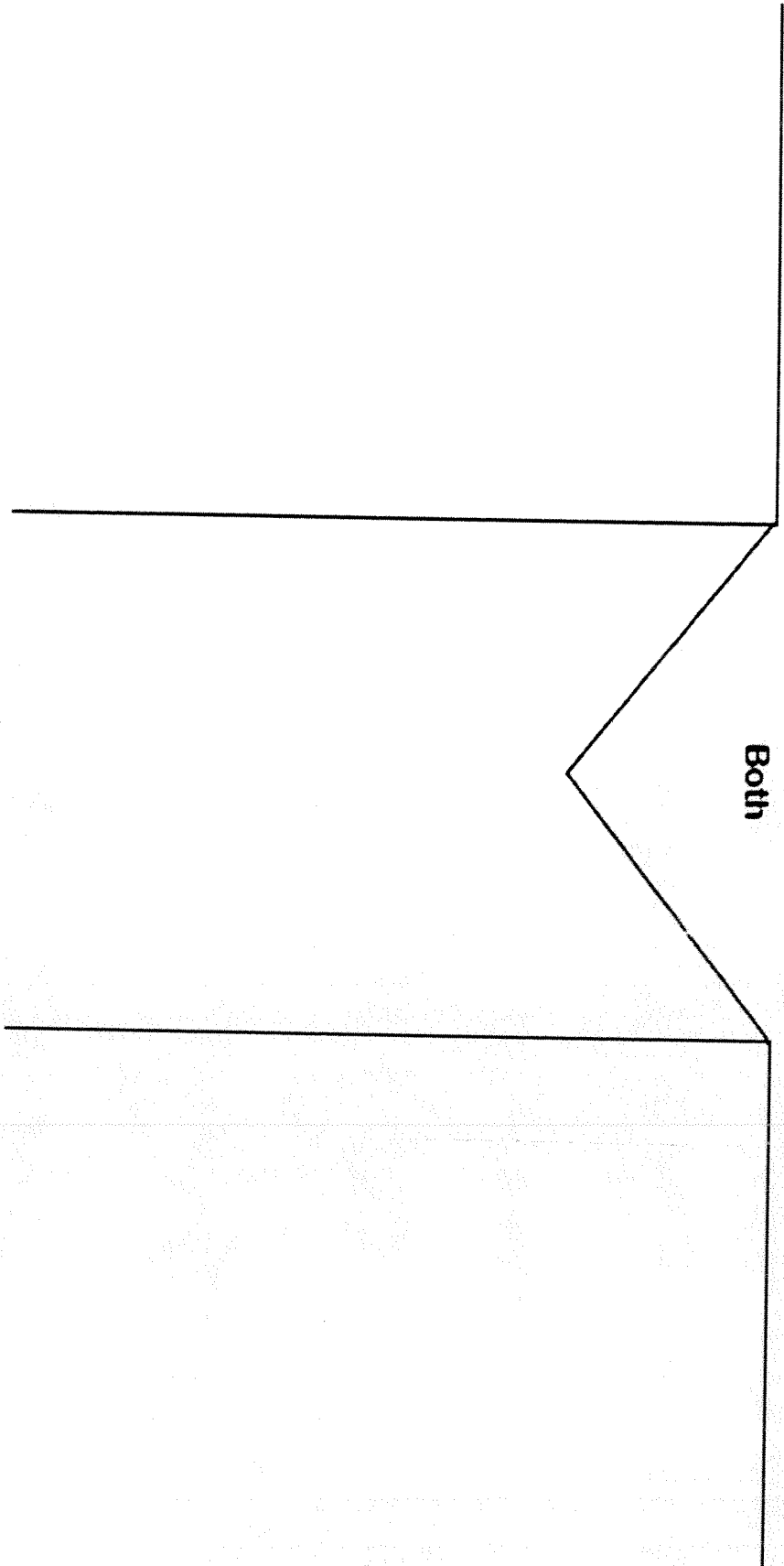

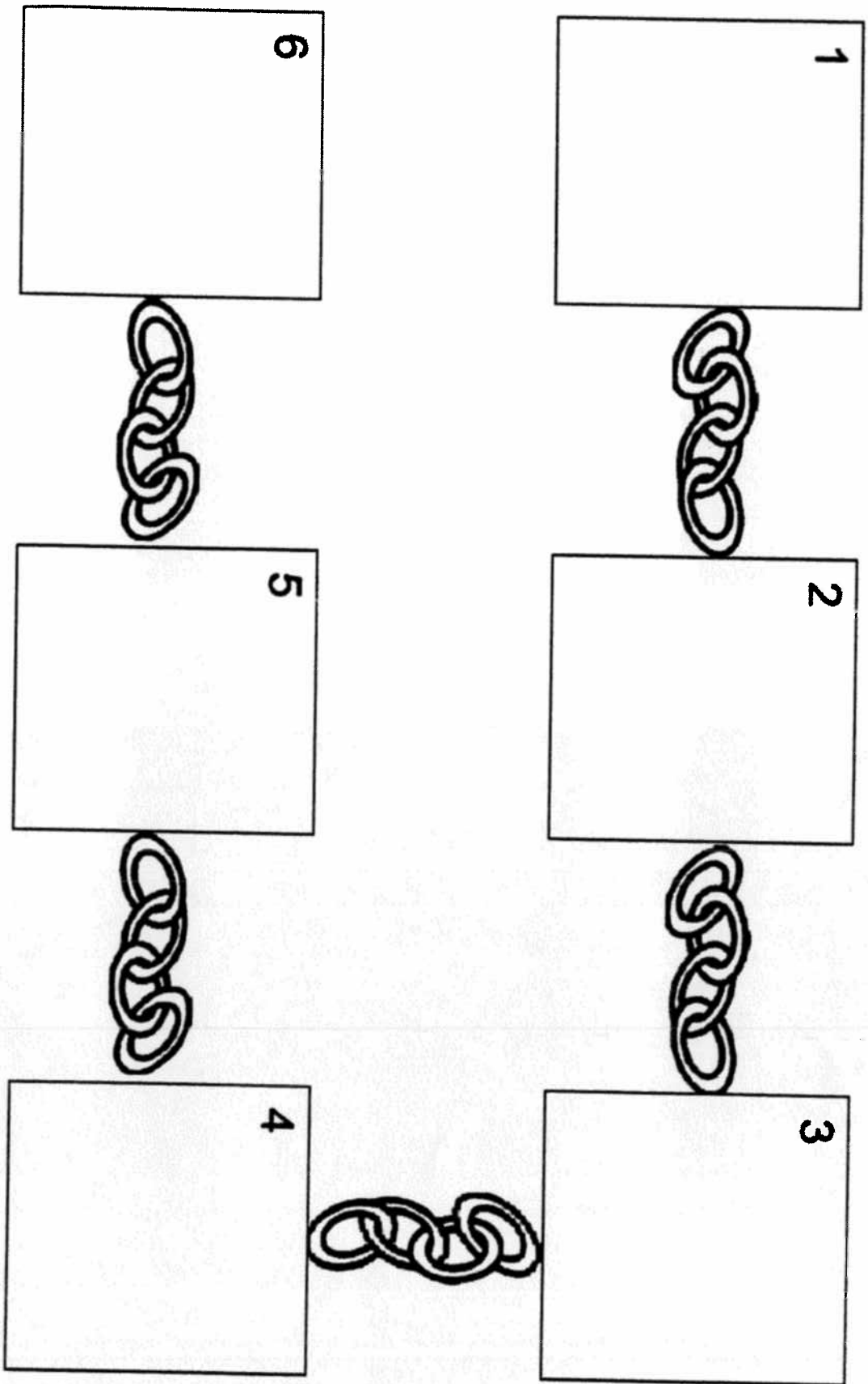
